

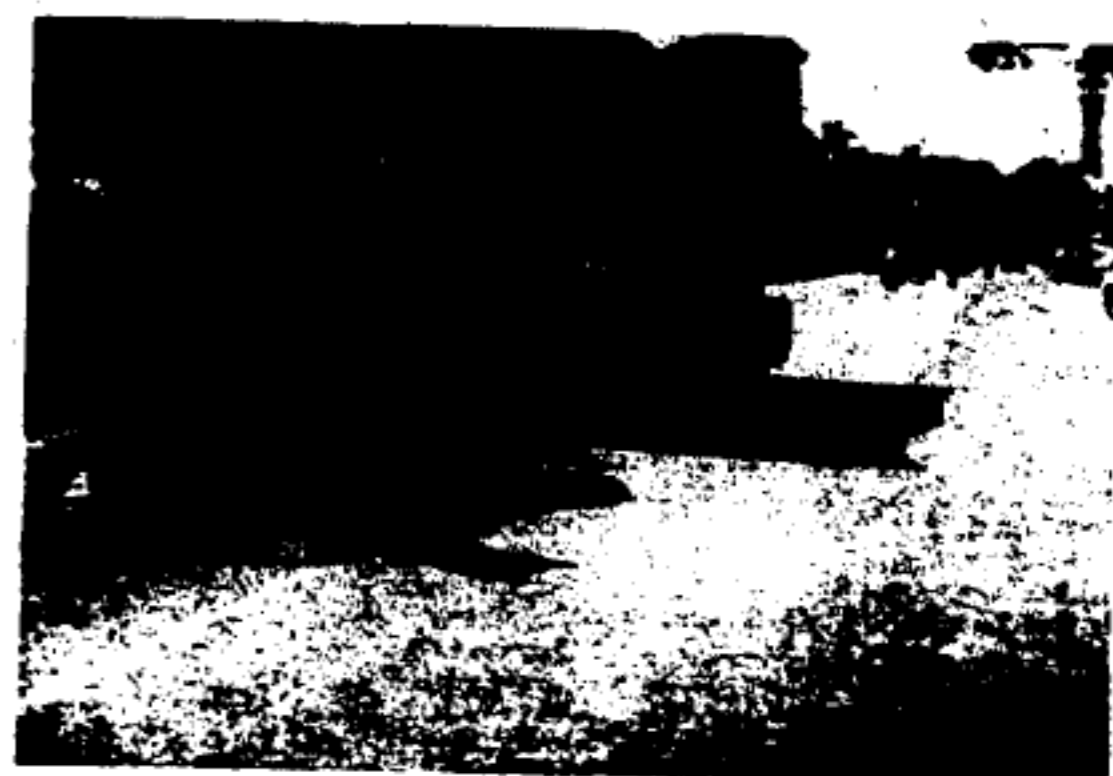
Birthday Party Pictorial

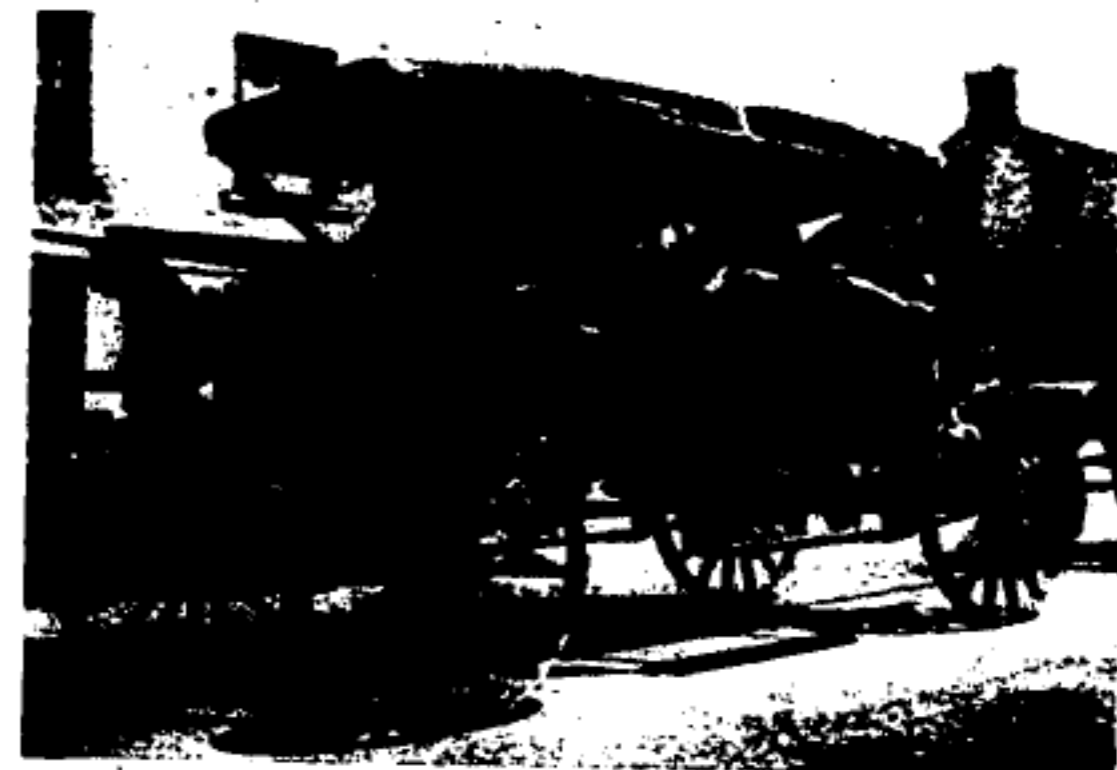

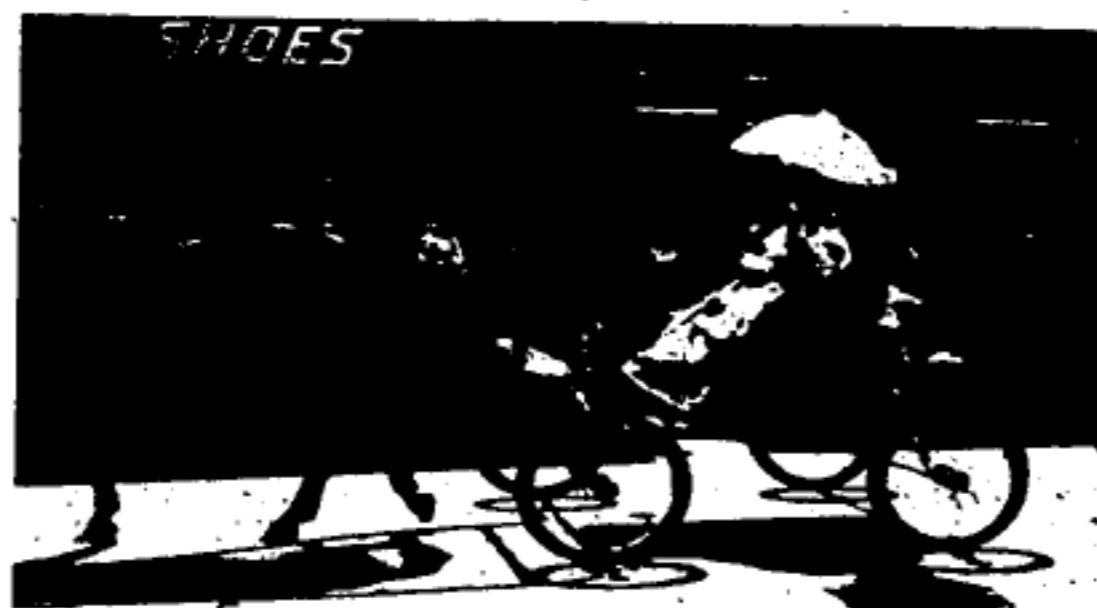
