Ottawan Bob Slipp wins Glen Tay Block race

 East Ottawa Lions running club member Bob Slipp captured first place in the Glen Tay Block race held here Thursday, traversing the 14.7 kilometre course in 47:50, just about two minutes over the 45:30 race record set in 1976 by Doug Scorrar.

His time was generally regarded as an accomplishment, given the hot, humid conditions which the more than 100 registered runners faced.

Second place was earned by Darrell Menard of Kingston, who came in at 48:37.3; and third was gained by Toronto runner Dan Melnick, in 49:26.

The top female runner was Val Hinsberger of Ottawa, who came in 41st overall, in a time of 59:42.1. Second senior woman across the finish was Ottawa-NCRA runner Susan Woodside, who completed the route in 60:45.4; and third was Shirley Hambleton, who stopped the clock at 65:57.3.

Derek Spafford of Napanee was top junior male runner of the day, in 53:54, followed by Kemptville runner Rob Wade, who clocked in at 54:15.4; and Terry Lemay of Smiths Falls,

who gained third place in a 59:25.5 effort.

Fifteen year old Lynn Parrington of Ottawa was top junior female runner of the event, when she completed the loop in 64:13.5. Kris Percival of Perth was second place junior runner, in 70:13.1.

In the Masters category, Dave Pedley of Kanata posted the top performance when he entered 17th overall, in a time of 54:56.1; Perth Runner Terry O'Hearn nailed second place in 55:40.7; and Dennis Featherstone of Nepean took third in 56:25.4.

On the distaff side, top masters runner was Ottawa's Erika Van Meurs, who completed the run in 66:74.0, followed by NCRA runner Barbara McLeod, who got back in 67:58.7. Roseann Wilson of Nepean took home the honours for her third place finish in that category,

in a time of 80:46.5. Top masters runners over 50 were Marj Daniels of Ottawa, who ran the course in 81:42.9; and Ian MacLaine, also of Ottawa, who finished in 64:12.2.

Although they did not register giving their home addresses, it is believed that there were runners in the field from England, Australia, and the United States.

The annual race is sponsored by the Perth branch of the Legion, and by the Perth Runners.

The men's winner received the Bill Wilson Memorial Trophy from Jack Wilson, and the top woman received the Perth Runners trophy.
