**Glen Tay Block Race Results...** The weather cooperated with the some 83 runners who gathered on Gore Street to race in the **Glen Tay Block Race**. The athletes got off to a good start although reports came back that the time at the one mile mark was slow. Perth Native, **Doug Scorrar**, 36, stormed over the finish line with little competition at the 49.13 minute mark. **Craig Ross**, 17 of Smiths Falls and a **Perth Runner** finished the race at 52.57 minutes to take first place in the junior men's category while **Lynn Parrington** of Ottawa, 16, came through the chute at 62.14 for first place in the junior women's class.

The first place winner in the men's master class was **Graham Beasley** of Ottawa with a time of 51:01. None of the runners beat the record time set by **Doug Scorrar** in 1976...45:30.
