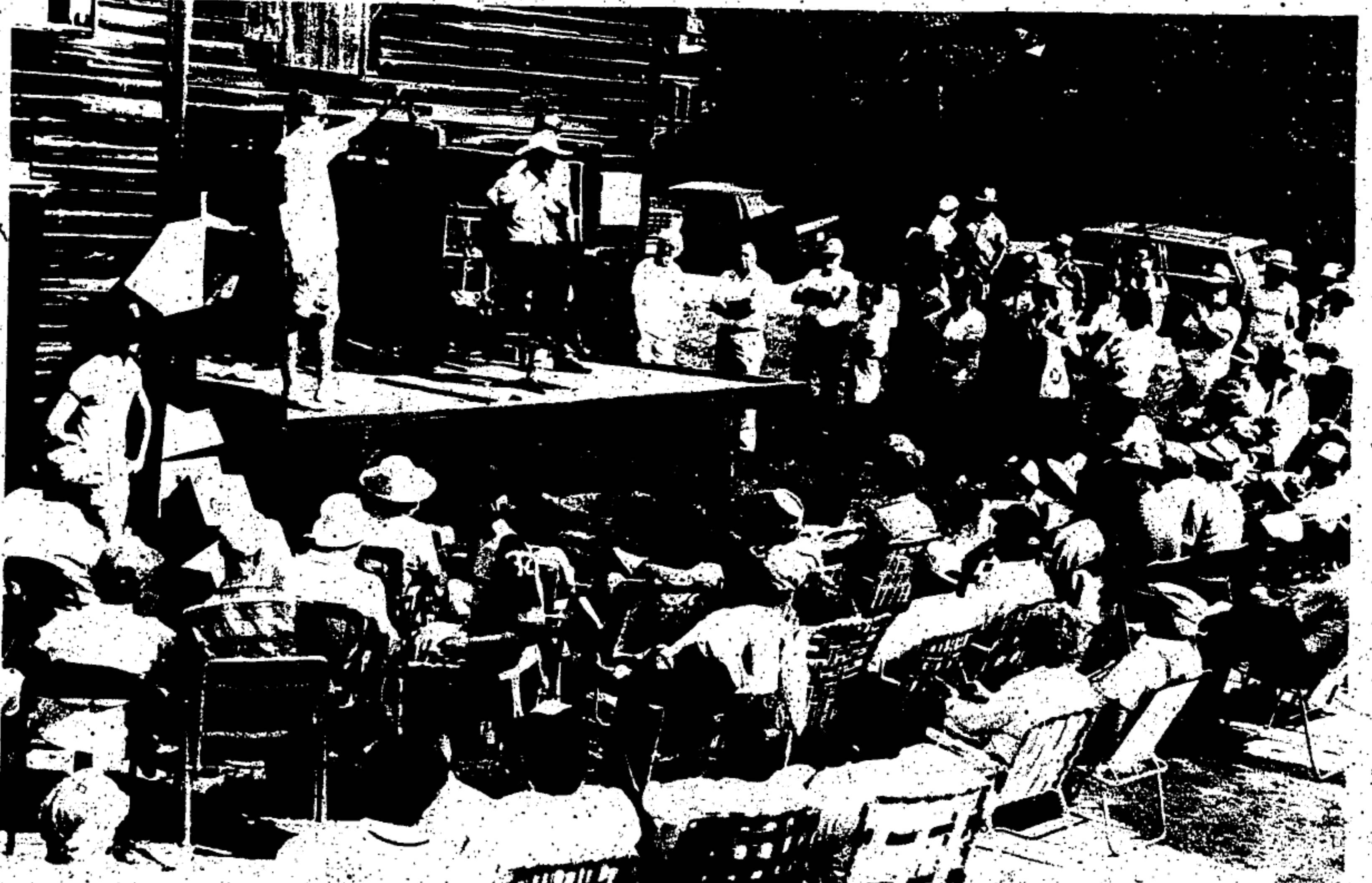
Eleven year-old Chris Burke, of Perth, was the first under 15 male across the **Block** Race finish line with a respectable time of 72:14.
